The Equipe Watch Company has created the "100th Big Block" Chronograph watch, a limited production timepiece made from 316L surgical stainless steel and hardened, non-glare mineral crystal that features luminous hands and markers, a Mivota/Citizen movement and a black rubber tire tread or stainless steel band. This watch was designed in Detroit, and like all Equipe watches, it features identifiable automotive-themed parts in its piston head crowns; it also sports the Chevrolet bowtie emblem in a "100" graphic. 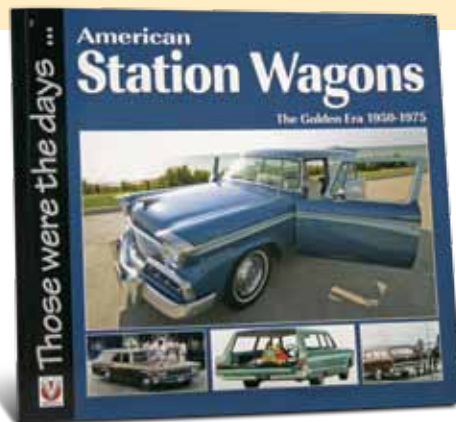
